Last week I met with my regional manager in regards to our current enrolments and what can be done to further support our school. I would like all families to rest assured that even though we are a small school there has been no discussion surrounding a possible closure of our school. I understand there are many families who have left our school who were concerned about this and are still talking about St Charles. I encourage all families to come and speak to me if you have any questions or concerns. It is very sad that rumours are still continuing. I am always happy to clarify anything you have heard.

Last year we were chosen by MACS to host international students at our school. This relationship is continuing this year and has provided many benefits for our students as they build their social and emotional skills. Based on the number of international students who arrived at the same time several weeks ago, we have implemented a new induction to ensure all students transition well into our school setting. As our school continues to grow this opportunity will not continue due the consistency required to keep our class sizes authentic to our community setting.

On the 12th March we will be having Parent/Teacher/Student interviews during the school day. Please note that this will be a school closure day however students are required to attend the interview with the parent. Please keep an eye out for bookings next week, these will be shared with you via compass.

Ensuring all our students and families feel safe and happy is key to what makes our school the welcoming and supportive community that it is. We will be sharing with you the MACS code of conduct to review- once you have read over it all families are asked to return to school the final page which acknowledges you have read the document.

As of the 18th March we will be having a little change in our office. Gabee, the Principal at St Kevin's reached out to our school for some help as they have not been able to fill their office manager role since last year. # CHILD SAFE STANDARDS

## Child Safe Standard 1

Child Safe Standard 1 addresses the importance of creating culturally safe, welcoming and inclusive environments for Aboriginal children and young people, and their families. Schools must meet specific requirements relating to this standard regardless of whether there are Aboriginal children and young people currently using their services or facilities.

## Standard 1

Organisations establish a culturally safe environment in which the diverse and unique identities and experiences of Aboriginal children and young people are respected and valued

### *What this looks like in practice at St Charles Borromeo Primary School;*

- We are proud to have students who are 'Fire Carriers'. Fire Carrier's bring Aboriginal culture, history and spirituality into the forefront of education in Catholic schools.
- Acknowledgement of Country at the beginning of each school gathering provides our students with an opportunity to show respect for Traditional Owners and the continuing connection of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples to Country.
- Flags are displayed in each classroom. displaying flags from different countries in the classroom or using them in school events promote cultural awareness.
- Ongoing staff professional development
- Policies and procedures available that describe MACs expectations and provide detailed guidance about actions staff, volunteers and leaders must take to establish a culturally safe environment in which the diverse and unique identities and experiences of Aboriginal children are respected and valued.

### Wellbeing

Whitefriars has partnered with The Resilience Project to cultivate resilience and emotional wellbeing among boys, emphasising the significance of mental health in their overall development.

Every Friday, students gather with their peers in their respective year levels or Pastoral Care groups for a dedicated wellbeing session. These sessions cover a range of topics, including mental health, stress management, and self-care. These sessions are led by a teacher who offers a supportive environment, encouraging students to express themselves, seek assistance and receive guidance from their peers who are at an appropriate age and experience level.

Students also have access to a number of allied health specialists including Psychologists and Speech Therapists.

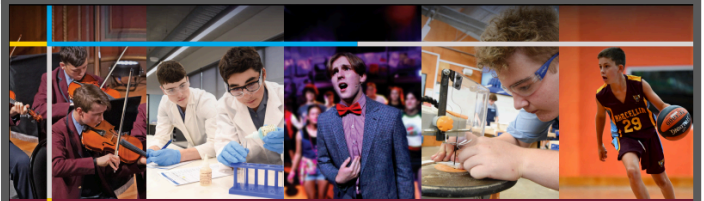
